- Notre Dame's 89% FED Rate for all student-athletes, ranks the University 3rd among NCAA Power Five Conference institutions. (Northwestern-95, Stanford-93, Notre Dame-89)
- Notre Dame ranks tied for 1st among Power Five institutions on a percentage basis (.773) of teams with 100% GSR scores (17 of 22). (Notre Dame, Duke)
